

Due to increasing costs the quarterly assessment will increase from \$64 to \$76 per quarter beginning April 1.

MAINTENANCE

We've repaired and refinished the docks, bridges and gazebo. We gained funds to help maintain the lake. The county has several projects to complete - grading/seeding by the gazebo and lake inflow filtering.

We're getting bids for groundskeeping, cleanup of common areas, and planting of ground covers on curbs and bare spots. The HOA assessments won't cover everything, but we'll make the dollars stretch as far as possible. Many thanks to everyone who helps keep our grounds clean!









Volunteers removed 32 dead trees. More are struggling and may also need replacing.

New trees were planted along Luck's Lane, on the lot where trees were stripped, and bushes were planted on the median. Additional trees will be planted to fill some gaps.

Luck's Lane expansion funds were supplied by the county to cover these replacement plantings.
